

2017 Harold Asselstine Memorial Trophy

Participation Requirements

In any South Port Sailing Club event in 2017, boats must come out to at least half of the completed races in a series to be *eligible for an award*.

Eligibility

The Harold Asselstine Memorial Trophy is awarded to the best spinnaker boat in SPSC hosted competitions. To be eligible for the trophy a boat must be *eligible for an award* in a spinnaker division (PHRF or one-design) for at least four of: the Spring and the Fall Thursday-Night Series, the Open Series, the Invitational Regatta and the Harvest Moon Regatta.

Scoring

From the five listed events the ranking in each division of those *eligible for an award* will yield event scores. Unbroken ties within each division shall distribute their event scores in a manner akin to rule A7. A boat's overall score will be the total of her best four event scores. Ties will be broken according to rule A8.1. If a tie remains between two or more boats, they shall be ranked in order of last of the events listed above (the Harvest Moon Regatta). Any remaining ties shall be broken by using the tied boats' event scores in the next-to-last of the list of events and so on until all ties are broken. An event score shall be used even if it is an excluded score — a boat that is not *eligible for an award* in the event will lose the tie breaker to one that is.

Prizes

The Harold Asselstine Memorial Trophy will be presented at the Fall Furl Awards Banquet.
