## 1 Rules

**1.1** This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in [The Racing Rules of Sailing](#), and the Sailing Instructions for the regatta.

**1.2** The official notice board is in the clubhouse's enclosed porch. Notices will be [mirrored on the web site](#) when possible.

## 2 Eligibility and Entry

**2.1** The regatta is open to all boats of the Laser, Laser Radial, Byte, Optimist and Club 420 classes. Other classes can be supported by special request.

**2.2** Eligible boats shall enter by completing the online entry form and paying the entry fee by cash or cheque at registration.

## 3 Registration and Fees.

### Meals:

The \$50 entry fee include breakfast Saturday & Sunday, snacks on the water, and Saturday night dinner.

A \$25 meal package is available to coaches and non-racers.

RC volunteers eat for free.

### Coaches:

Coaches and support boats must register in-person and list the fleet(s) and competitor(s) they are coaching/supporting. A numbered flag may be issued at check-in and must be displayed. Coaches may not dock following racing until they have confirmed that all the competitors are inside the SPSC harbor.

Coach and support boats are required to monitor assigned channel on their VHF radios and be available to assist with safety when requested.



## 4 Schedule

4.1 The registration periods are on Friday between 1800 – 2100 and on Saturday between 0900 – 1000. Payment of the entry fee will be accepted at either of these times.

4.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Saturday is 1200.

4.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Sunday is 1000.

4.4 No warning signal will be made after 1400 on Sunday.

## 5 Safety

Life jackets must be worn at all times while afloat.

Boats must have a minimum 5 meter long, 6 mm minimum diameter towline attached to the mast at all times. This towline cannot be normal running rigging.

## 7 Courses.

The courses will be windward/leeward between inflatable marks.

A total of 8 races will be the targeted.

**8 Scoring.** Three races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

**9 Prizes.** Prizes will be for first, second and third place in each class.
