

## Sailing Instructions

Sunday September 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020

#### 1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in Racing Rules of Sailing.

# 2 CHANGES & SKIPPERS' MEETING

Notice to competitors will be posted on the official notice board in the clubhouse porch. There will be a skippers' meeting at 1300 hours. Any changes to the sailing instructions will be posted and discussed, and the starting times will be distributed.

#### 3 SCHEDULE

The first warning signal will be at 1355 hours. GPS time. This is a pursuit race: starting times for individual boats will be assigned at registration and announced at the skippers' meeting.

#### 4 RADIO

The RC will broadcast on channel 68.

All participants are to call in their finishing time and the name of the boat ahead and the boat behind.

#### 5 AREA & MARKS

The race will start and finish at SPSC starting mark, a white can buoy.

Mark 1 is a white can buoy. DP7 is a green light buoy CC is a white can buoy.

#### 6 COURSE

The race course will be determined at the skippers' meeting.

**#1 RED** - **6.4** Nautical Mile Marks to Port

From the starting line to 1 (port), to CC (port), then to DP7 (port), to 1(starboard), and finish at starting mark.

**#2 RED- Short** - **6.0** Nautical Mile – Marks to Port From the starting line to 1(port), then to DP7 (port), to 1(starboard), and finish at starting mark.

**#3 GREEN** - **6.4** Nautical Mile – Marks to Starboard From the starting line to 1(port), then to DP7 (starboard), to CC (starboard), to 1 (starboard), and finish at starting mark.

#### #4 GREEN - Short - 6.0

Nautical Mile- Marks to Starboard. From the starting line to 1 (port), then to DP7 (starboard) to 1 (starboard), and finish at starting mark.

#### 7 START & FINISH

The start and finish line will be between the orange ball and SPSC starting mark.

### 8 STARTING SIGNALS

This is a pursuit race, the slowest handicap level will start first. Each handicap level will have its own start time as assigned by the RC and as distributed at the skippers meeting.

#### 9 TIME LIMIT

The RC will monitor the radio until 1700 hour. Boats finishing after are to take their own time and record the boat ahead and behind.

#### 10 PROTESTS

The protest time limit is 1 hour after the 1700 hour. Any offending boat is to take appropriate penalty as per racing rules at time of infraction.

#### 11 PRIZES

Prizes are SPSC Hospice Race flags in PHRF and JOG divisions and the Hospice Dove flag for the boat with the most money raised. If you make a donation on line, please make sure that the donation is credited to SPSC and the boat on whose behalf the donation was made.
