1.0 RULES

1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the CYA, the International Shark Class Association (ISCA) General Class Rules and Specifications, and this Notice of Race, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions.

1.2 The regatta is designated category A under RRS Appendix G.

2.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRIES

2.1 The regatta is open to Shark class sailboats

2.2 In addition to the requirements of RRS 75.1, a boat must be registered by a member in good standing of a Shark Class National Association, and that person must be the person in charge (RRS 46).

2.3 RRS 78.1 is modified so that a boat which does not comply with class rules concerning measurement or does not have a valid measurement certificate may compete, and will not be subject to protest under the rule, if:

- a) it complies with all other class rules
- b) it has not competed in another CSCA sanctioned counter regatta that year
- c) it has not been issued a valid measurement certificate within the past five years
- d) the person in charge has signed the statement of understanding on the entry form.

4.0 LAUNCHING & MOORING

Launch / haul out is on the South Port property. The dry-sail crane is available at all times. Trailers will be stored in the southwest portion of the SPSC parking lot. Moorings for visiting boats are located within the SPSC basin. Local boats will be requested to haul out only after all of the out of town boats are on their trailers. Our guests come first!

5.0 REGISTRATION

6.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Sailing Instructions will be posted on the South Port website and on the Official Race Notice Board in the screened porch area of the clubhouse. They will also be made available at the registration desk.

7.0 SCORING

7.1 When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

7.2 A minimum of 1 race is required to constitute a regatta.

8.0 CREW SUBSTITUTIONS

Substitution of crew during the regatta must be approved in writing by the regatta or protest committee chairperson.

9.0 PRIZES & TROPHIES

The winner of the regatta will be presented with the "Hal Ebert Memorial Southwestern Regional Shark Championship Trophy". Keeper prizes will also be awarded to the top 3 skippers and crews.

10.0 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

11.0 INSURANCE Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$2,000,000.
