

(Temporary) Changes to SIs owing to the Ongoing Restrictions of the Emergency Management Act **Amendment active 27Jun2020**

- 1. Rules
- The Racing Rules of Sailing shall largely apply; however
 - The rules of Part 2 are replaced by the Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea.
 - You are competing against the course and not other boats.
 - 1. This impacts Rule 2 FAIR SAILING.
 - 2. All boats, must at all times, maintain a minimum separation of 5 boat lengths.
- And all Covid-19 based rules/laws of Ontario Sailing and the Windsor-Essex County Health Unit applicable on the day of each race.
- 2. Course
- Will be determined at a 6PM Skippers Meeting and displayed on the Club Bulletin Board (temporarily a Sunroom porch window).

3. Starting

- There will be no starting sequence -- Rule 26 and the Starting and Class Flags Sailing Instruction does not apply.
- There may or may not be, a start line -- if not, boats shall pass by the fixed start mark and record their own time.
- There may or may not be, a finish line -- if not, boats shall pass by the fixed finish mark and record their own time.
- Boats shall start as they please any time after 184500 (6:45PM) and before 191500 (7:15PM) on the night of the event.
- Boats shall report recorded times to the organizers via a convenient remote means.
- 4. Protests
- Protest hearings are not allowed
