**Time Schedules/** On the day of the race; Changes to the SI's will be posted by 12:00, All Drysail boats must be launched by 14:00, A skippers meeting will be held at 15:00, First warning will be at 16:25

Classes to Race/ Shark One Design, JOG, PHRF A B C as required (class splits may be adjusted)

**Class Flags/** Boats racing must fly from the backstay a coloured flag indicating her class; Shark, none; JOG, white; PHRF C, - blue; PHRF B – green; PHRF A – yellow

**Certificates/** A current valid rating certificate is not required except to qualify for ECPA awards. In JOG and PHRF classes a boat must either; A, have been rated by ECPA with no modifications since. Or B, have been issued a rating by a North American PHRF station and have an equivalent rating on file with ECPA. Ratings must conform to current ECPA usage.

**Insurance/** Boats must carry sufficient insurance for all eventualities.

**Registration & Facilities/** The entry fee is \$30.00. Visiting boats may make use of the harbour, dockage dry storage, and facilities Friday through Sunday for no additional cost. Drysail hoist is available under the supervision of a qualified SPSC member for launch and haul out. Please contact the Harbourmaster at harbourmaster@southportsailingclub.com for harbour navigation and dock and hoist usage.

**Racing Area/** The racing area is the southwest portion of Lake St. Clair. Mark locations are approximately; SP#4 42\*20.234N - 082\*50.149W; Other marks are charted government buoys. The Weather Buoy ODAS 45147 is at 42\*25.8N - 82\*41.0W

**Participation & Scoring/** This race will be one long distance race of between 8 and 23 nautical miles. Scoring to comply with the current RRS scoring practices.

**Prizes/** SPSC Harvest Moon Regatta flags will be awarded after the event.
