SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sunday
September 8th, 2019

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 CHANGES & SKIPPER'S MEETING

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board in the clubhouse porch.

There will be a skippers' meeting at 1300. Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before the meeting.

3 SCHEDULE

The first warning signal will be at 1355.

This is a pursuit race; starting times for individual boats will be assigned at registration and announced at the skippers' meeting.

4 RADIO

The RC will broadcast on channel 68.

5 AREA & MARKS

Mark	Latitude	Longitude
4	42°20.234'N	82°50.149'W
R6	42°22.845'N	82°52.476'W
DP7	42°20.834'N	82°54.407'W

The race will start and finish at SPSC mark 4, a white can buoy with an orange top. Shipping channel mark R6 is a red nun buoy. Peche Island outer shoal mark DP7 is a green light buoy.

6 COURSE

The RC boat shall display a numeric and colour placard for:

#1 Red — 8.8 Nautical Mile Triangle — Marks to Port From the starting line, sail 3.1 nautical miles 334° magnetic to R6 — 2.5 nautical miles 223° magnetic to DP7 — 3.2 nautical miles 108° magnetic to the finish line.

#2 Red — Short 6.2 Nautical Miles — Marks to Port From the starting line, sail 3.1 nautical miles 334° magnetic to R6 and then back 154° magnetic to the finish line.

#1 Green — 8.8 Nautical Mile Triangle — Marks to Starboard From the starting line, sail 3.2 nautical miles 288° magnetic to DP7 — 2.5 nautical miles 43° magnetic to R6 — 3.1 nautical miles 154° magnetic to the finish line.

#2 Green — Short 6.4 Nautical Miles — Marks to Starboard From the starting line, sail 3.2 nautical miles 288° magnetic to DP7 and then back 108° magnetic to the finish line.

7 START & FINISH

The start and finish lines will be between the orange flag on the RC boat and SPSC mark 4.

STARTING SIGNALS

Each handicap level will have its own starting signal. The race shall be started by using the following signals replacing rule 26.

INDIVIDUAL RECALLS

When signaling individual recalls, the race committee shall momentarily wave flag X with one sound and announce the sail number on the radio. This modifies rule 29.1.

8 TIME LIMIT

The RC boat will be on station until 1700. Boats finishing after are to take their own times and record the boat ahead and the boat behind.

9 PROTESTS

The protest time limit is 1 hour after the RC boat docks.

10 PRIZES

Prizes are SPSC Hospice Race flags in PHRF and JOG divisions and the Hospice Dove flag for the boat with the most money raised.
